President's Message

The ABPA Annual Education Conference and Trade Show held in Phoenix, AZ the first of May was very informative and I brought back a lot of good information that I will try to share with you. First, congratulations to our Chapter for receiving a Presidential Award for Chapter Excellence (PACE) Award. This award goes to Chapters whose activities throughout the year have supported the organization and educated the public on ways to ensure our public water source remains safe.

A few presentations of note were Assembly Theft, Residential Risk, Conducting an Effective Survey, and Mobile Landscape Chemical Services and Their Hazards. The Assembly Theft presentation was by a detective with the Phoenix Police Department. Metal theft is at such a high level in that area, that they have a list of prohibited items that cannot be sold by the general public – backflows are on that list. They have found that spraying the device with bed liner paint is a deterrent to theft. Of course, you'll want to avoid the test cocks and serial number plate. The Residential Risk presentation, by an Illinois Master Plumber, was very enlightening. She indicated that those opportunities for risk have increased mainly due to the level of customization available to homeowners. The complete list she presented can be found on page 6 of this newsletter.

The other two presentations that I'll highlight here have to do with survey work. The first provided a list of items critical to being prepared for the survey:

- Make an appointment unless it is a problem facility
- Meet with the person who knows the facility, e.g. the piping
- Know the type of facility and their process beforehand
- Review plans/blueprints beforehand, if available
- Determine if the survey is for containment or isolation
- Watch your words "I want to learn" and "I need to understand" are more likely to get information and results
- Success is based on corrections made after the survey

And the tools that will aid you in the performance of the survey:

- 1. Start at the potable entrance
- 2. Review checklist of potential cross connections
- 3. Laser pointer to follow piping
- 4. Review findings with the customer
- 5. Require definitive time frame for corrective action

These types of water users were noted as potential for contamination


- Fertilizer spraying trucks
- Landscape companies
- Pesticides Health Department mosquito sprayers, City horticulture trucks
- Sewer flushing trucks need to inspect KUB sewer flush trucks to ensure air gap is maintained
- Mobile car wash, pet cleaning, carpet cleaning
- Any tank truck other than Potable water trucks
- Street sweepers
- Nurseries

Residential Survey Items

The following is a list of residential risk items that can be used when conducting a residential survey. Consider looking for these items when determining if backflow protection is needed.

Bath:

- 1. Anti-siphon ball cocks in toilet
- 2. Bidets without built in backflow
- 3. Submerged inlet in sink bowls
- 4. Hoses in tubs that reach below overflow or submerged inlet

Kitchen:

- 1. Disposals without air gap
- 2. Direct-connect soap/chemical dispensers
- 3. Reverse osmosis systems
- 4. Water dispensers in fridges (filters not changed causing bacteria to build up)

Other:

- 1. Laundry tubs with hoses
- 2. Pet washing stations
- 3. Ice maker drains in floors
- 4. Water treatment device drains
- 5. Water powered sump pumps, boilers

Outdoor:

- Water hose hazards from chemicals and pressure washers hooked to supply
- 2. Animal water dispensers
- 3. Water features
- 4. Water vacuum w/direct connect
- 5. Drain cleaning equipment
- 6. Campers
- 7. Home dialysis


