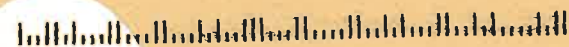
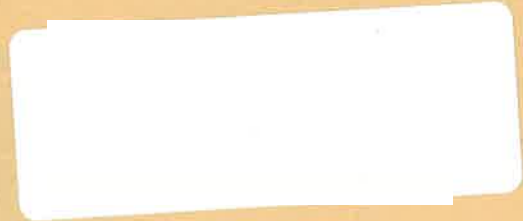

## TBPA West Section News

**The High Cost of Untrained Backflow Installers**  
By Kris Munson, Watts Water Technologies

In this newsletter we will look at another factor contributing to the high cost of using untrained labor to install a backflow device. The factor we will discuss that may add to this hidden cost is: Improper Installation.

### Improper Installation

As a backflow manufacturer we have seen many pictures where you sit back and ask what were they thinking when they installed this unit. When someone who has no involvement with the backflow preventer after its initial installation, installs the unit, you have no guarantee of what to expect.

The ramifications from an improper installation can range from something that is not aesthetically pleasing but will function normally and is within approved installation requirements, to something that a tester is unable to test and if it breaks will pose a danger to the water supply due to its improper installation.

There are national codes that have been developed for the proper installation of a backflow preventer but currently an installer may not be familiar with these installation codes and requirements. The codes have been developed to ensure that when the backflow preventer is installed properly, the unit will function correctly, have adequate clearance for servicing, have adequate drainage/protection for nuisance discharges of the relief valve and will protect the water supply in case of a failure of the water supply or during a backflow condition.

When backflow preventers are submitted to the various approval agencies for certification testing, we as manufacturers, have to specify what orientations the assemblies are to be tested in. These orientations may be published in the product literature, on the manufacturer's website or on the approval agencies' website or approval literature. The backflow preventers are only approved in the orientations that they were tested in at the certification agency, any changes to the orientation of either the unit or its shutoffs will void the agency approval for that unit.

Since some installers have a limited interest in what goes into a correct installation, the end user may be left to deal with what was installed when the tester arrives to perform the annual test. The results could range from being inconvenienced during the test; to the unit being un-testable due to its installation and having to re-pipe and re-install the backflow preventer to make sure that is complies with the national and/or local codes. Depending on what is necessary to correct the installation, there may be undue resentment towards the tester and the manufacturer regardless of whether or not they had anything to do with the initial installation.

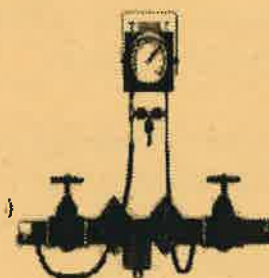

### Treasurer's report
