We will be in Murfreesboro this year at the Double Tree Hotel on October 18th & 19th. Mark this on your calendars and start making plans to attend.



The High Cost of Untrained **Backflow Installers** By Kris Munson, Watts Water Technologies

In this newsletter we will look at another factor contributing to the high cost of using untrained labor to install a backflow device. The factor we will discuss that may add to this hidden cost is: Improper Support of the device.

Improper Support

How many backflow manufacturers do you know who list their unit as a "pipe alignment device?" Although I could find no manufacturers who list that as a design feature, there are many installers out there who use the backflow preventer as just that. The concern is that the backflow is designed and tested as a "no-load" device. By using the backflow preventer to align the pipe, undue stress may be put on the backflow. This may not cause a problem if the misalignment was minor, but if the misalignment was great enough, it could cause bodies to crack, shutoff valves to not operate properly, or internal components to be non-removable without first relieving the stress from the

This condition would normally be completely hidden after the installation was completed and would not typically appear until either the backflow cracks from the stress or the internals cannot be removed when the unit is opened for service. In either case the possibility is there for a significant charge to correct the installation so that the backflow is returned to a "no-load" connection and it is repairable, this is a tough situation to identify due to the fact that the backflow may look perfectly normal and it is not until a later point in time that the misalignment is

Something that directly relates to using a backflow as a "pipe alignment device" is improper thrust blocking or support of the unit. In contrast to what was stated previously, a backflow unit may be installed with "no-load," but also without any external support for the unit and its shutoffs. This may be acceptable at the time of installation, but as the ground settles the piping and backflow may shift thereby creating stress on the unit. This is another situation that is tough to identify at the time of installation, but with adequate support as part of the backflow preventer installation, the hidden costs previously mentioned can be reduced or eliminated.






