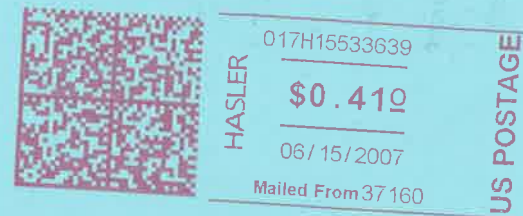
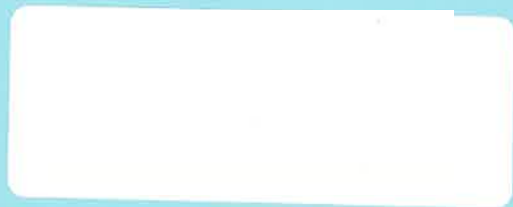

House Bill #2121 / SB785

This bill would allow someone with a Master Plumbing License or a CMC-S to install domestic potable water fire systems in the state. The fire sprinkler people want to meet and discuss this issue before it moves forward.

House Bill #2122 / SB786

This bill will require someone wanting to get their State Master Plumbing License to prove 2000 hours of experience or have an engineering degree or have held a LLP for three years. This bill passed as amended

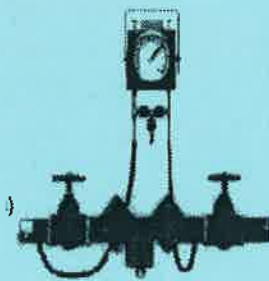
