



Treasurer's report

Balance \$12,083.54. This total includes an investment CD of \$5,200.00.

ABPA Concerns

Larry addressed the Board with his concerns about ABPA. Bruce Rathburn, President of ABPA, was in attendance to answer the questions Larry presented. Larry expressed dissatisfaction with the lack of people running for office and the finances of ABPA. Bruce indicated he questioned the ABPA Board about spending \$75,000. 
