Bill Hunt

The Robert Lashlee Lifetime Achievement Award

We thought you might like to know a little more about this man who has devoted his life to the backflow industry.

William Michael Hunt was born February 20, 1924 in Cory, Pennsylvania. Since birth, thru unforeseen circumstances he was raised in a Catholic orphanage in nearby Erie until he was seventeen. WWII broke out and on September 19, 1942 he joined the Navy. He spent three years serving in the south pacific and was discharged in 1945 in Long Island, NY.

He moved to Mobile, Alabama to take a job with Crane Company. There he met his future wife Ramona while she worked as a secretary at the naval shipbuilding yard. Bill and Ramona married in 1951, lived in Nashville for a time and eventually moved to Memphis when Bill took a job as a Wade representative in 1957. There they opened Central Sales Co. Even though he sold the business to his son and daughter-in-law in 1991 he remains active.

Bill has been associated with many organizations and groups throughout the years. Two of those dearest to him are as a founding member of ASPE Memphis Chapter and working on the cutting edge of backflows for water safety. Bill has always had the heart of an educator and still to this day never turns away an opportunity to educate, even when there was never going to be a sale. Many of you remember the lively presentations he has done at our TBPA Conferences.

Bill's ever-optimistic attitude is that he wants to give back more than he receives and still enjoys the people and the organizations that have contributed to his enjoyment and success over his fifty five years in business. Bill and Ramona have been blessed with four children and ten grandchildren. They continue to count their blessing for the friendships, memories, and successes that this industry has bestowed on them.




