In reviewing some recent incidents of backflow on the Backflow Diva's website, I came across a case that occurred almost six years ago, but was just settled in court in 2012. The family living in the home was awarded nearly a one million dollar settlement. There were a number of errors that caused this terrible situation. The case involved a water purification system that had a drain connected to the home sewer service pipe. The contractor who installed the system did not obtain a permit for the work; therefore there was no inspection by the local building authorities. The family continually called the company to report that their water taste did not improve, but in fact worsened, after the installation. This isn't the only family affected by this company's failure to follow code and respond properly to their customers. Now they have potentially hundreds of lawsuits. If you own your own business, the time and cost of defending this type of legal procedure can be devastating. Always make sure you are following local code where you are working. Always get an inspection.

We have a presentation at the 2013 Annual Conference that speaks to issues of liability for utilities, but the same could apply to you as a business owner. This is just one of the many pertinent and informative presentations we have lined up for you. We are excited about our diverse topics and speakers this year, and we look forward to spending time with our fabulous vendor sponsors.




Michael has been an active member of the ABPA since 1990. He is the Environmental Scientist for the State of Utah, Division of Drinking Water in Salt Lake City, UT.




The Double Tree Hotel where this year's event will be held is newly renovated and very nice. Bring your family and make a fall vacation in Chattanooga.
