

In 2013 Grady was awarded the Robert Lashlee Lifetime Achievement Award from TBPA.





### **ABPA Harrington / Arthur Memorial Scholarship**

2016 Topic: Backflow prevention and cross connection control not only protect the drinking water in day to day applications, but it can also be a protection against terrorist acts. Tell the public what backflow hazards you would suggest for them to be aware of and how to protect the safe drinking water through backflow prevention in your community.

The scholarship is available to any high school student over 13 and under 20 years of age as of December 31st and legal residents of the United States or Canada. The essayist is NOT required to be college bound! It can be used for any type of advanced education.
