

## **TBPA East Section News**

I hope everyone has had a great summer! I'm sure most of us have been busy with testing/repairing of Irrigation backflows. A friend sent me a picture of an irrigation backflow - Febco 825Y. Many of us have seen people put in a extra diaphragm on the relief valve to keep it from dripping around the relief plate. (the reason for this is because the relief valve plate can warp when the owner either waits to late or does not winterize the system)

Will it stop it from dripping? Yes. Will it pass the test? Sometimes. It will not let the relief valve open enough to dump. Is this the correct way to repair it? No!!



In the above picture someone put a different thicker gasket in place of the original Febco diaphragm and I'm guessing after tightening the bolts with the thick gasket it still leaked so.. What's a man to do? Break out the good ole C-Clamps and not 1 but 3!



As I walked around the house to test the backflow device shown above..Booyah! There is a Hornet's nest on the relief valve. Did the relief valve open above 2.0? Yes, three months later.

These are just a couple of situations you may encounter as you work to test irrigation devices on your system. Always remember to stay safe.
