## **East Tennessee News**


I hope everyone has had a great summer! Fall is upon us and it is a nice break from the summer heat! I'd like to share a cool story:

Everyone who is a Tennessee Volunteers fan knows "The Voice of The Vols" to be Mr. John Ward and he unfortunately passed away this summer. I had the pleasure of meeting Mr. Ward many years ago when I was still working for the utility in Knoxville. Mr. Ward loved flowers so much that not only was his yard full of flowers he even purchased land next to his home and it too was full of flowers and Dogwood trees. He had a walking trail which he welcomed anyone to come visit and it was amazing! Of course he needed to keep it all watered; as we all know irrigation systems must contain a RPZ backflow and be within 12" above the ground. As luck would have it, I visited one day and his backflow was placed in a nice home-made box. When I opened the lid all I could see were the test cocks. I went ahead and tested to see if it would pass and it had failed! This is when he had the pleasure of meeting me to not only tell him his backflow had failed, but he also had a lot of dirt to remove. As we approached the backflow, I explained the situation and then instructed what needed to be changed in order to be in compliance; as we walked to the back of his home, I could tell he was detail-oriented. He understood the importance of the backflow and how it was incorrect with all the debris around it. He told me he was sorry and didn't realize that it was out of compliance; otherwise, he would have corrected it before then. I knew the gentleman he said that would correct it and was certain that he was in good hands. After he made his own notes on what needed to be corrected, he then began to just speak about anything and everything and was incredibly humble. Mr. Ward even kept me informed on the progress and one day sent two pictures (see below) of the before and after. The very next week I ran into the gentleman who fixed the backflow and he told me that Mr. Ward wrote a letter to his company saying I had spoke highly of him.

# **Plumbing Safety**

Everyone is on high alert when the subject is about contaminated drinking water or perhaps when a water heater has blown through a roof, resulting in a serious injury. Unsafe plumbing is serious and against the law --as a law abiding citizen, the property owner must follow the plumbing code and strive for safe and sanitary systems. We do not have one American plumbing code for the entire country; all the plumbing codes strive to produce results. The point is whichever "plumbing code" one chooses to follow is not of importance; however, the fact that one follows the code is what matters. Plumbing system safety and avoidance of unsafe plumbing are based on principles of good plumbing practices.

This would include proper installation of safety valves such as backflow prevention devices, water heater T &P valves, and hot water tempering valves. The property owner must ensure regular safety testing and preventive maintenance. Plumbers often don't inform the homeowners what needs to be done. Many think plumbing codes speak solely to the plumber, which is only partially true. The plumbing codes speak to the code official and the property owners. Plumbers are not instructed to teach property owners these codes; however, plumbing safety depends on the professional of the plumber.

The code official is a regulator and, as such, has a duty to ensure that property owners maintain their plumbing as outlined by the codes. This requires inspections of backflow prevention devices and water heater safety valves for example. Safety devices are to be maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's published instructions and other specifications that are stated in the code book. There is no room for plumbing officials to turn a blind eye to the code requirements for maintaining plumbing safety valves. The code officials must have re-inspection programs or give the job to someone who can follow the plumbing codes as it is vetted.

Plumbing accidents happen as a result of careless enforcement by the plumbing officials and property owners who have not been informed on how to keep a safe and sanitary system. When the code official fails to act, it is simply reckless and it is what contributes to injuries and damage to property. Both of these situations are why plumbing codes are so important to follow. The code officials are mandated to enforce that the codes are followed correctly.

### Make certain that:

- Property owners maintain a safe and sanitary system in accordance with the plumbing codes
- Property owners need to be informed that plumbing codes exist and why they are to be followed
- Unsafe plumbing shall be repaired, rehabilitated, demolished, and/or removed by the property owner
- Owner is responsible for maintenance of their plumbing systems
- All devices and/or safeguards required by the codes shall be maintained in compliance with the manufacturers published instructions
- The plumbing official shall require any plumbing system to be re-inspected
