President's Message

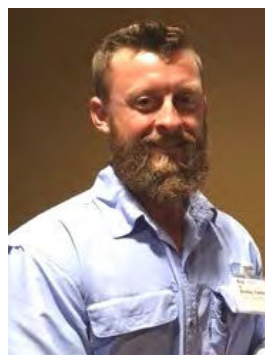
Greetings and Happy Holidays to everyone!

ABPA Harrington / Arthur Memorial Scholarship

2019 - 2020 Essay Contest Topic: *Explain backflow prevention and why it is important in protecting potable water supplies. Discuss some of the hazards that could be a threat to our drinking water, and the types of backflow prevention to protect against them.*

The Scholarship is available to any high school student over 13 and under 20 years of age as of December 31st and legal residents of the United States or Canada. The essayist is NOT required to be college bound! It can be used for any type of advanced education.

Essays must be submitted based on the required topic with an official application form and be 700-1200 words. The winner will receive a \$1,500 scholarship. Winners of under this competition are not eligible to win more than once. Entries must be received by 11:59 EST on January 31, 2020.
