East Tennessee News

I hope everyone is staying safe from the COVID-19 pandemic! It has just been a crazy year for everyone! I know most utilities are restricting travel and exposure. In light of this, TBPA will not be hosting the annual conference this year. I have had a few of you ask me if I have changed my mind about canceling the repair class I planned to host this year. In order to prioritize the health and safety of all of you, I still think it is for the best to wait until next year.

It is hard to believe that it is almost fall! We saw a wet spring here in East TN which caused a delay in activation of a lot of irrigations. I feel like I was behind the whole summer just trying to keep up with the testing! While out on repairs this summer, I failed a new backflow assembly on a brand new irrigation system that was put in this spring. Both the repair person and the homeowner called me to explain that 2 bolts were found in the #2 check valve. The bolts were the same type of bolts that are on the relief valve plate, but all of the bolts were still on the relief valve. I guess somewhere there is a backflow assembly that is missing 2 bolts on the relief valve!

This summer I also had 2 different repairs that failed the retest. When I talked with the repair person and told him that the #2 check valves failed again, he told me that he had stretched the springs as far as he could and flipped the rubbers over. I explained to him that when you stretch any spring, after time it will return back to its original form and length, so our problem was most likely the check rubber. On the next retest with a new check rubber, it still failed. We then put in a new spring and it passed. I have had people tell me ever since I started testing backflow assemblies in 2001, that they have stretched the springs in this type of situation. As in any situation, a quick fix is not a fix; it is just a Band-Aid. This type of solution will always cause more time and money to be spent in attempt to fix the real problem. We never want a Band-Aid solution keeping the public potable water safe!

We offer our sincerest condolences to Roger Crane after the passing of his mother back in June, and to Keith Stevens after the passing of his father in August. Please keep both of these men and their families in your thoughts and prayers during this very hard time. To Roger and Keith: I lost my father 39 years ago and my mother last year, so I personally know what you both are going through. I am here for you, my friends!

I hope everyone has a great fall. Enjoy the cooler weather and the beautiful colors of the season! And as always, stay safe!
