ABPA Harrington / Arthur Memorial Scholarship

2020 - 2021 Essay Contest Topic: Describe the meaning of backflow prevention and how we can keep our drinking water safe through cross connection control. Identify potential hazards commonly found in a typical residential household and discuss actions needed to correct them.

Deadline: February 28, 2021

The ABPA Harrington Memorial Scholarship Essay Contest was established to reward students who seek to increase their knowledge and understanding of how cross connection control and backflow prevention help ensure safe drinking water. The Scholarship is available to any high school student 13 to 18 years of age as of December 31st who is a legal resident of the United States or Canada. The essayist is NOT required to be college bound! Award monies can be used for any type of advanced education.

Essays must be submitted based on the required topic with an official application form and must contain 700-1200 words. The winner will receive a \$1,500 scholarship for higher education. Previous winners of the ABPA Harrington Memorial Scholarship Essay Contest are not eligible to be awarded again.
