Letter from the President

Hello members of the TBPA,

Spring season is now upon us and I feel certain that a few of us will have some irrigation backflows that will fail testing due to the freezing weather from our past winter and their single degrees temps. It seems that some customers don't realize the importance of winterizing their irrigation equipment because water and freezing temps don't work well together.

I have been approached in the past few years about using software dedicated to backflow prevention. And I think it's a great idea to use something like this to avoid using so much paper, which also takes up a lot of space in our offices. But as with anything new, some people don't like to change their ways. Our dept uses an asset management software to assign work orders for anything that is done by our maintenance people. In example, for leak checks, meter changes and since last year backflow testing reports. If our testers come up on a situation such as relief valve leaking, cross connections, device too low, and etc. We have them take a video or picture with the iPad /tablet for whatever unusual issue they find. It adds these to the work order attached to the asset, in this case the backflow device. And is documented for the State to see and to show the customers. And with this, I was just wondering how many of you are still using paper for everything and how many of you are using tablets and software for testing nowadays. I feel like this could be a discussion topic at our conference.

And also, the TBPA is working steadily to organize the <u>26th Annual TBPA</u> <u>Conference</u> and are getting close to completing all the details.
